# CEDAR LAKE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (CLID)

The CLID and Scott Watershed Management Organization are collaborating to offer this tournament as part of the overall CLID lake management plan.

The common carp is a nonnative invasive aquatic species that severely impacts water quality in shallow lakes and wetlands. Their feeding habits disrupt shallow rooted plants, muddying the water and releasing phosphorus from lake sediment, increasing algae blooms. Proper carp management has been shown to improve water quality and promote plant growth which will be essential in reestablishing native plants in Cedar Lake.
