

## **2015 3RD ANNUAL CARP KABOB TOURNAMENT**

**May 15,16 2015**

The 3rd Annual Carp Kabob bow fishing tournament brought comfortable temperatures and calm skies at the 10 pm start. Stability helped fishermen to have their best year yet in the Carp Kabob.

Team 4 of Nathan Boyer/Austin Linder/Katie Capaul arrowed 15 fish and secured the \$1,000 first place prize, their largest fish weighing in at 33 lb. 8 oz. They also sliced and diced their way to the Mr. Whisker award with 9 bullheads. Justin and Craig Scheffler, along with Matt Zoubek, boated 15 fish, the largest 24 lb. 9 oz., for a \$500 second place check. 2013 Champs Grant and Shane McNeilus, along with Corey Klampe, locked up 3<sup>rd</sup> place and \$250 with 13 fish. Zack and Charles Stans had slightly better luck in 2014 when they took 1<sup>st</sup>, but showed consistency by boating 9 fish for 4<sup>th</sup> place and \$150. It took 7 fish, along with a whopper at 40 lb. 6 oz .for John Love, Jacob Love and Brian Schroeder to cash the 5<sup>th</sup> place check and 2<sup>nd</sup> big fish check. Jeremy Scheffler and Joe Hesse brought in the pig of the day with a 40 lb. 13 oz. monstrosity, good for \$250.

In all, 85 fish were harvested (carp and a few suckers) along with 16 bullheads. There were 12 fish taken over 30lbs. The top 10 fish ranged from 31.1-40.13. Two fish exceeded the 40 lb. mark. It's estimated that 1500-1800 lbs of fish were removed from the lake.

Thanks to all of the fishermen, volunteers and onlookers that came to the weigh in. We appreciate the shelter and accommodations that Scott County/Three Rivers provided at Cedar Lake Farm. We also thank the Scott WMO, MN DNR, Scott County Sheriff's Dept and homeowners in the CLID for assisting in the planning and/or being supportive of this event as part of the lake management plan.
