RESOLUTION NO. 2012-157; AMENDING RESOLUTON NO. 81016 INCREASING THE CEDAR LAKE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS FROM FIVE TO SEVEN MEMBERS AND RE-DEFINING THE BOARD'S MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 81016, as amended by Resolution Nos. 81039 and 90106, created and empowered the Cedar Lake Improvement District (CLID) in Scott County; and

WHEREAS, the Cedar Lake Improvement District Board of Directors is currently comprised of five members; and

WHEREAS, the Cedar Lake Improvement District Board of Directors is implementing the recently completed Cedar Lake Improvement Plan (Plan) to improve the water quality of Cedar Lake; and

WHEREAS, implementation of the Plan is a multi-year effort and will increase the responsibilities of the Cedar Lake improvement District Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, the Cedar Lake Improvement District Board of Directors has recommended the addition of two (2) members to its Board to enable successful implementation of the Plan; and

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 103B.551 outlines the membership requirements of a Lake Improvement District established pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 103B.51; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Scott County Board of Commissioners that it is desirable to amend Resolution Nos. 81016, 81039, and 90106 to increase the membership of the Cedar Lake Improvement District Board of Directors from five to seven members and to bring the District's Board of Directors' membership requirements within statutory guidelines.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners in and for the County of Scott, Minnesota, that the membership for the Cedar Lake Improvement District Board of Directors is increased from five members to seven members upon endorsement of the increase by the membership of the CLID at its next meeting.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with Minn. Stat. § 103B.551, Cedar Lake Improvement District board members shall be elected by persons owning property in the District at the annual meeting of the District. The Board of Directors of the District must include persons owning property within the District and a majority of the directors must be residents of the District.
